

Undergraduate Teaching Assistants

UCSC calls applications for the post of Undergraduate Teaching Assistants (UGTA) from the current UCSC 4th-year students. The post of UGTA is a limited opportunity for students with higher GPA, who would like to get university teaching experience during their undergraduate studies, which will be greatly helpful when applying for TA positions at foreign universities. If you wish to do higher studies and join academia, you are highly encouraged to use this opportunity to improve your teaching skills.

Application details, duties and responsibilities of the UGPA as described below.

1. If you are a 4th-year student of the UCSC with more than a **3.5 GPA**, you can apply for the post of UGTA.
2. Only the 1st year and the 2nd year practical/tutorials will be assigned for the UGTAs.
3. Applicants will be interviewed by the head and the respective coordinators to verify their teaching abilities and subject knowledge.
4. Selected applicants will be appointed as UGTAs for specific subjects for ONE semester under the complete guidance and supervision of the respective course coordinators.
5. The role of the UGTA will be over as soon as the semester ends, and they will NOT be responsible for any further activities of the course.
6. All the practicals and tutorials conducted by the selected UGTAs will be scheduled only in the free slots of the UGTAs to avoid disturbances in their academic activities.
7. UGTAs will NOT be involved in marking/grading assignments/practicals or in any other way in the examination process.
8. UGTAs will not be paid, but a letter will be issued to them appreciating the service rendered at the end of the semester.
